that shared their dream,
PACE was born.

Many activities took place the first few years
by volunteering and serving

giving & working in telethons,

and more rewarding was serving the homeless.
It soon became apparent that the
one activity which stood in the forefront,
was helping African-American
high school females achieve
their dream of obtaining a college education.

For over twenty years PACE
has raised money and awarded scholarships
up to \$1,000 per recipient,
presented each year at the annual
"Spring into Summer"
Luncheon and Fashion Show.


